136 in favor
110 against
19 abstentions

Richard Adams was challenged over serious conflicts of interest during the EESC Plenary Session due to his stakeholder position with RWE AG, one of Europe's five leading electricity and gas companies along with his Trustee position for the Charity Sustainability First with an interest in Smart Grid and Smart Meters.
